Our offer

An **employment contract starting August 1st, 2026**. We offer different contract terms based on the candidate's current residency status, subject to the discretion of our management team. For candidates we need to relocate from abroad, we provide a package including a two-year contract and a potential annual renewal. For candidates already residing in Singapore, we offer a one-year contract with the potential for annual renewal. Please note that expatriate benefits are not available for locally-based candidates.
